___ I/We plan to engage the assistance of friends or family members to paint the quilt square with guidance provided by the Watauga County Arts Council as needed.

___ I/We prefer to be matched to a community group which will paint the quilt square. (In making this request, it is understood that there may or may not currently be an available group and that it may take some time to locate an appropriate group to paint the square.)

___ I/We would prefer to pay a \$250 fee to the Watauga County Arts Council to engage the services of an artist to paint the quilt square.

In making this request, the undersigned agrees to accept the following conditions and requirements. Please initial each line below to indicate your agreement:

___ I/we will work with the Watauga County Arts Council regarding design and colors of the proposed barn quilt square.

___ The quilt square will remain on the building at least two (2) years. After that time, the quilt square will remain on the building until the owner asks for it to be removed or it becomes apparent that the piece needs to be repaired or renewed.

___ Barn or building site must be visible from the road or on a site that is frequently visited. The Arts Council will have the final say as to the appropriateness of the site.

___ If paid for by WCAC, the barn quilt square is the property of the Watauga County Arts Council after removal from the site.

___ If paid for by the WCAC, any leftover or unused materials will be returned to the Arts Council for use in future projects.

The Watauga County Arts Council will provide the following from the grant funding provided by the Blue Ridge Heritage Area through Handmade in America as long as the allotted funds shall last:

- Up to 2 sheets of exterior grade sign board (depending on size of quilt square)
- Lumber for frame
- Paint and painting tools/supplies (if needed)
- Installation of finished quilt square (equipment, supplies, manpower)
