Data from 40 core arts industries was gathered using the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) to estimate industry activity, and the Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) System was used to identify 41 core arts occupations.



Please note: The Creative Economy was majorly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic beginning in March 2020.


SECTOR & INDUSTRY

In the NAICS hierarchical structure a Sector is at the top and an Industry is the most granular or final level.



2021 Earnings by Sector










Top 5 Core Creative Industries by Earnings









